Adults and children are welcome to enter one or more of the categories to show off their skills to the visitors on the day. There will be prizes for the winning entries .

#### HOW TO ENTER

1. Choose a category (list below)
2. There are 2 options for the entry form -either (i) complete the attached entry form, in advance or on the day, or (ii) complete the online version by using the QR code (on next page).
3. Get creating your entry .
4. Bring your entry, completed entry form and payment into St Lawrence church no later than 2.30pm on 30th November.

#### CATEGORIES

##### 1.ART

Can be a painting, drawing or collage in any medium on a Christmas theme.  
No larger than A3 – it can be framed or mounted.

##### 2 CRAFTS

Make a table centrepiece, wreath or set of christmas tree decorations (maximum 4 items).

##### 3 LEGO (inc. Duplo)

The lego creation must be;

- no larger than 38 x 38 cm base, and 38cm in height
- on a Christmas theme;
- it must be stable enough to be moved safely;
- not a pre-designed kit.

##### 4 CREATIVE WRITING

A 5-line limerick about Eastcote or Ruislip (keep it clean please)!

##### NOT SO DOMESTIC GODS AND GODESSES -

A fun category for those who are not so artistic / creative but don't want to be left out.

##### 5 THE MOST OUT-OF-DATE ITEM IN YOUR KITCHEN CUPBOARD.

##### 6. THE OLDEST COMIC, MGAZINE OR ANNUAL IN YOUR HOME.





## RULES

As with any competition there are a few rules:

1. There are 2 age categories within each group - school year 6 and under and school year 7 and over (including adults).
2. Each competition entry must be accompanied by an entry form (as above).
3. Entries, including payment, must be completed no later than 2.30pm on 30th November or they will not be eligible to be judged
4. Each entry Adult (18+) costs £2.00, 17 years and under £1
5. Each entrant may submit up to 2 entries per category
6. All entries must be the property and original work of the entrant.
7. Lego entries must be the entrants designs, i.e. not from a kit / set
8. Exhibits, forms and payment can be dropped off at the church on Friday 29th between 6 and 8pm, or Sat 30th from 10am – 2.30pm
9. Entries can be collected at the following times from the church:  
Saturday 30th November, 5-7 pm and Sunday 1st December, 9-9.55 am.  
If they are not collected or alternative arrangements not made by Saturday 7th December they become the property of St Lawrence church and will be appropriately recycled.
10. The competition area will be supervised at all times during the fair, and all reasonable care taken; however, entries are left at the owners risk
11. Judges' decisions are final and the organisers will not be able to discuss their decisions with entrants. The age of participants will be taken into account.
12. Contact details provided are only used for this purpose and will be securely disposed of once the competition is completed.
